GIVEN the project TNE23-00012 “Green & Pink for Sustainable Education” (**GPS^{Education}**) financed within the PNRR Missione 4 “Istruzione e Ricerca” – Componente 1 “Potenziamento dell’offerta dei servizi all’istruzione: dagli asili nido all’Università Dalla ricerca all’impresa” - Investimento 3.4 “Didattica universitaria e competenze avanzate” T4 “Iniziative Transnazionali in materia di istruzione”, supported by the European Union, NextGenerationEU - CUP D74G23000280006, whose Scientific Responsible for POLIMI is Prof. Raffaella Brumana;

CONSIDERING that the **GPS^{Education}** project aims to reinforce educational and scientific cooperation between Italian Higher Institutions and Partners Universities, on innovation in teaching, inclusive mobility, sharing academic development, promoting transnational mobility and advanced training;

GIVEN the existing interinstitutional Agreement between Politecnico di Milano and **Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Mines de Rabat (ENSMR)** through the MoU signed within this Project (Repertoire 14654/2025 Protocol 270550/2025) dated 04/11/2025, and the intention to collaborate with **Université Internationale de Rabat (UIR)**

HEREBY DECREES

the publication of this **call for application** for the allocation of **Scholarships**, for the participation to the **GPS^{Education}** project for research mobilities on WP4 Advanced Skills – T4.2, at one of the partner Universities listed above as follows:

-> **€ 3,240,00** maximum amount for a duration of the mobility of **14 days**.

-> **€1.910,00** maximum amount for a duration of the mobility of **7 days**.

The overall budget reserved for this Call for Application is **€ 19.440,00 for a total of N. 6 Scholarships**.
In case of residual budget additional positions will be considered and admitted to funding, according to the eligible candidates admitted to the ranking.

Art. 1 - Recipients

This call is addressed to professors and researchers (including RTDA, RTDB and RTT) of Politecnico di Milano, invited to carry out research activities at one or both the partner Universities (foreign associated member universities), within the GPS^{Education} project. During the mobility, the development of joint research activities on GPS^{Education} project topics is strongly encouraged, with the aim of producing joint publications.

Art. 2 - Application submission

Applications must be submitted via the following email address gpseducation-dabc@polimi.it by **December 15th, 2025 at 12.00 a.m.**

Applications must include:

- a curriculum vitae;
- a mobility application form, that will be completed using the template attached (Annex A).
- a valid identity document (identity card or passport).

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Art. 3 - Selection procedure

Applications will be evaluated by a selection committee based on:

- motivation of the mobility in the context of the GPS^{Education} Project
- overall objectives of the mobility
- foreseen activities
- expected outcomes and impact.

In case of equal score priority will be given to the youngest professor.

Selected applicants will be notified by **December the 17th, 2025** and must confirm acceptance of the scholarship **1 week before the Mobility at latest**.

The Mobility Agreement will be finalized using the template attached (Annex B) and signed after the selection and before the Mobility.

Art. 4 - Contributions

The **scholarship will be granted, as a reimbursement**, upon submission of **receipts for travel, accommodation and board** incurred during the mobility at Politecnico di Milano.

All mobilities must be completed, and reimbursements processed, by March, the 31st, 2026.

Art. 5 - Responsible for the procedure
